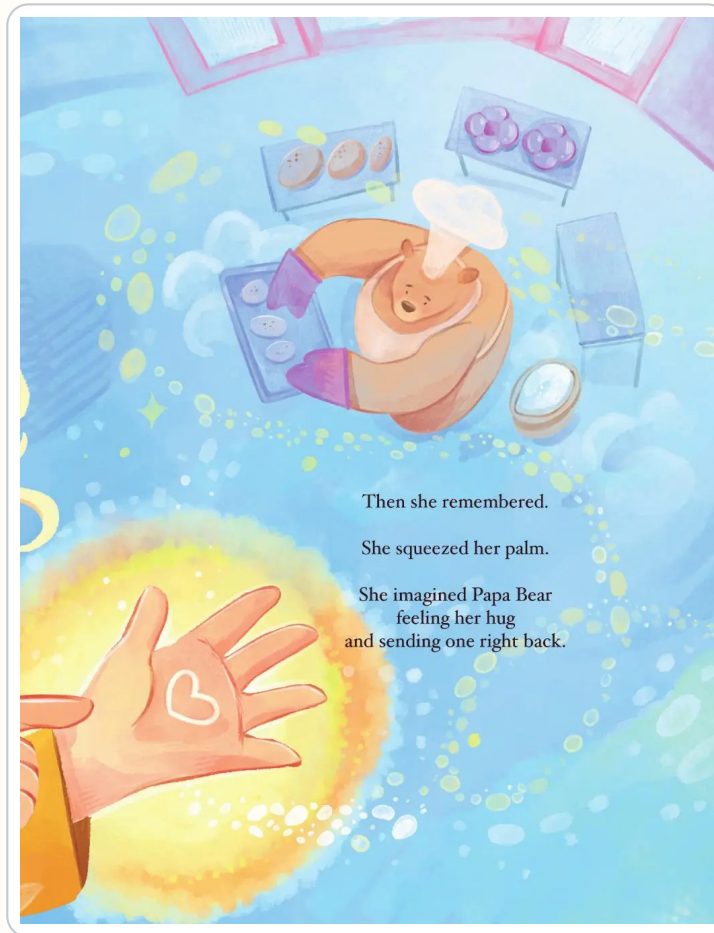

The Hug Button Kit

A little way to carry love with you

Inside: a printable Hug Button, four Hug Notes, a Look at the Moon bedside card, a make-your-own note, and a simple family ritual card.

PRINT ON US LETTER PAPER AT 100% SCALE

Choose only the pages you need. Adult help is recommended for cutting.

Take the Hug Button with you

Cut out the circle and keep it beside a bed, inside a backpack, or anywhere a small reminder of love might help.



How to use it

- 1 Place your hand on the button.
- 2 Think of someone you love.
- 3 Squeeze your palm and send your hug.



Four little hugs for later

Cut along the dashed lines. Tuck a note beside a bed, into a lunchbox, or anywhere it can be found when love is needed.

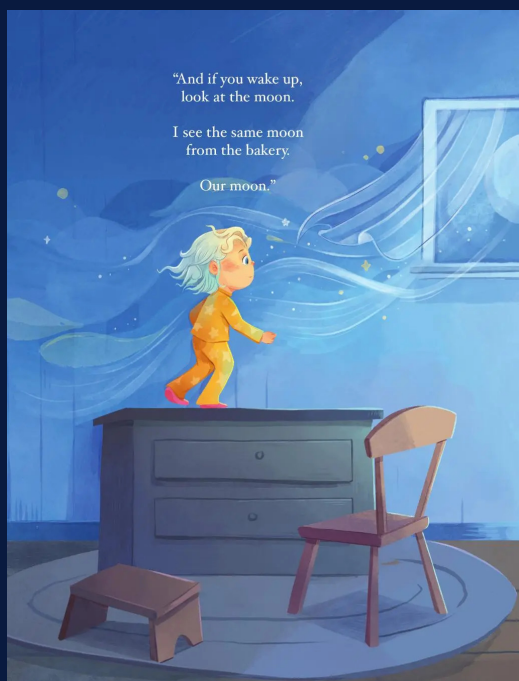

A 5 x 7-inch bedside card using the shared-moon words from the story.

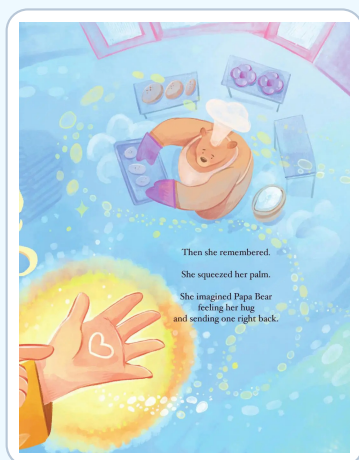


"And if you wake up, look at the moon.

A little message

Draw something that feels like a hug:

A large, empty rectangular box with rounded corners, intended for drawing something that feels like a hug.

FROM:

A goodnight ritual from the story

Keep this 5 x 7-inch card nearby as a gentle prompt. Use the parts that feel right for your family.



Love stays

A simple way to carry the book's bedtime ritual into your own home.

READ > HUG BUTTON > MOON > GOODNIGHT

1

Read

Share the story together.

2

Hug Button

Press or draw the button on a palm.

3

Moon

Look for the same moon.

4

Goodnight

Say goodnight, knowing love stays.

An optional hug for later: leave a Hug Note somewhere it can be found tomorrow.

Use the parts that feel right for your family.
