“I’m sorry it feels scary.”



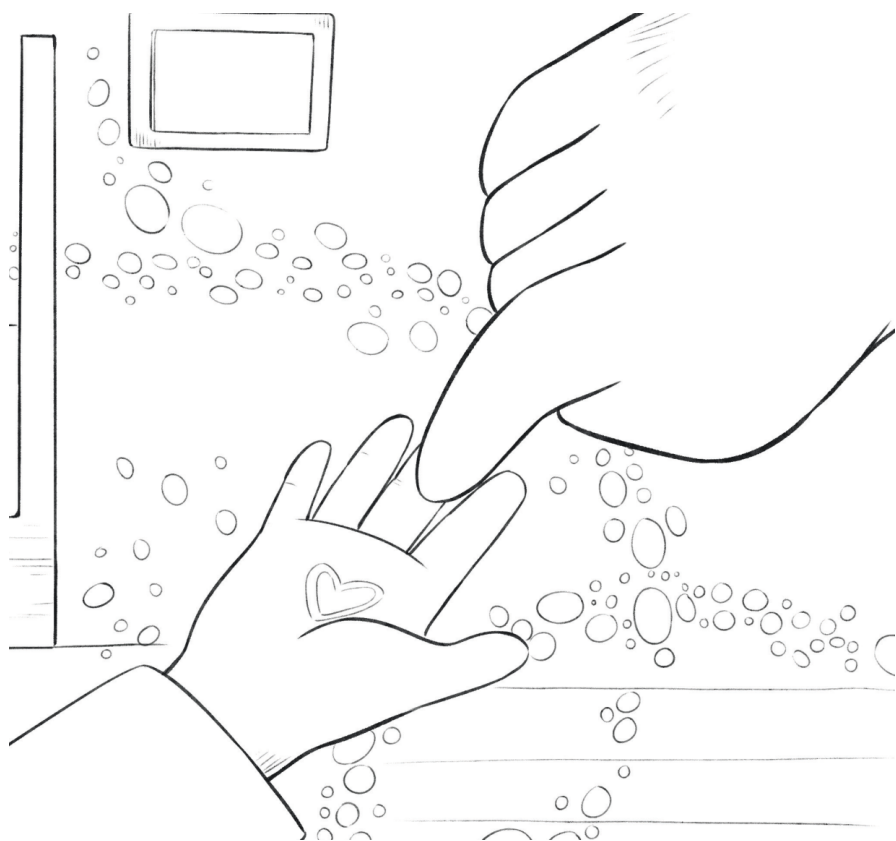
“I go to the bakery
